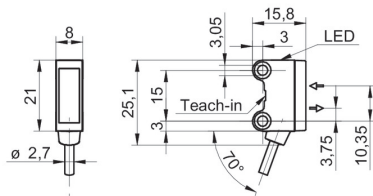

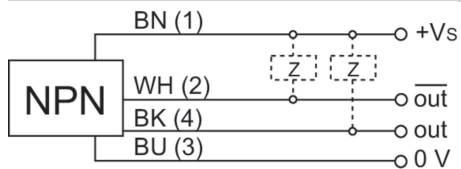

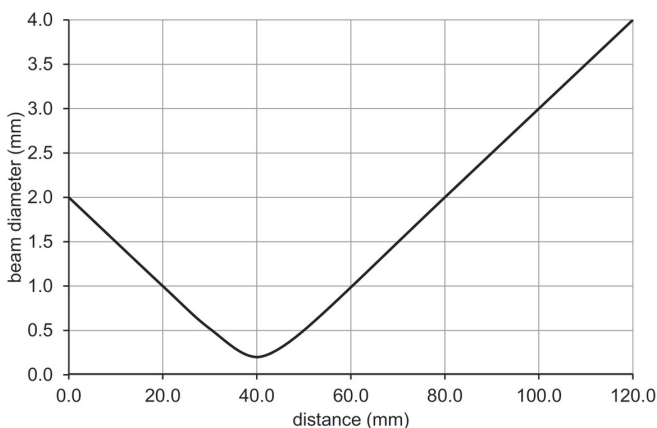

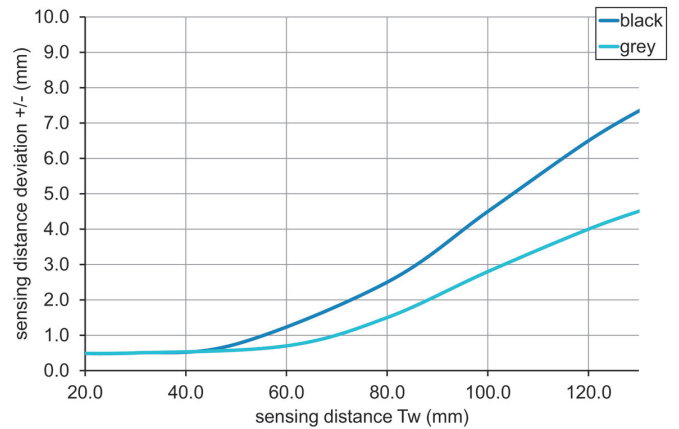
Connection diagram
